UPCOMING TRIP INFORMATION



AUGUST 16th - 18th Texas Springs, Nevada

The Club will be conducting an overnight weekend field trip to Jackpot, Nevada on Friday, August 16th and returning on Sunday the 18th.

We will be collecting all day on Saturday the 17th for petrified wood limb casts, snakeskin agate and paisley agate. Driving time from Ogden to Jackpot is approximately three and a half (3 ½) hours via I-15 north to I-84 west then south on US 93 to Twin Falls, Idaho and then continuing south on US 93 to Jackpot.

For those wanting to camp, there is a full hook up RV resort at <u>"Cactus"</u> <u>Pete's Resort Casino"</u> in Jackpot, otherwise hotel accommodations can be made at Cactus Pete's or at other casinos in Jackpot.

Please note, there are no primitive campsites where we will be collecting. The group will meet Saturday morning in the parking lot of the "General Store" which is located directly across the street from "Cactus Pete's Resort Casino" at 08:30 am (Mountain Time) and we will depart for the collection site NO LATER THAN (NLT) 9:00 AM.

The collection site is about an hour drive southeast of Jackpot and some of the roads are only suitable for trucks and SUVs.

Darrell and Darlene McRoberts will be the lead for this trip, so please let them know if you will be attending. You can call or text them at 801-317-7001 or 7000. Hope to see you there!
